The procedure is being updated to include the responsibilities and processes in relation to responding to a declared public health emergency (e.g. a pandemic) or other public health emergency, which are already being applied by state school operated residential boarding facilities through implementation of the COVID-19 <i>Guidelines for state school operated residential boarding facilities</i> . The procedure has also been updated to align with the recently reviewed <i>Administration of medication in schools</i> procedure and incorporate recent changes to human rights legislation and inclusion and behaviour policies.		
2. Summary of changes		
Changes to the procedure include:		
<ul> <li>incorporating responsibilities and processes in relation to a declared public health emergency or public health incident from the published COVID-19 Guidelines for state school operated residential boarding facilities;</li> </ul>
