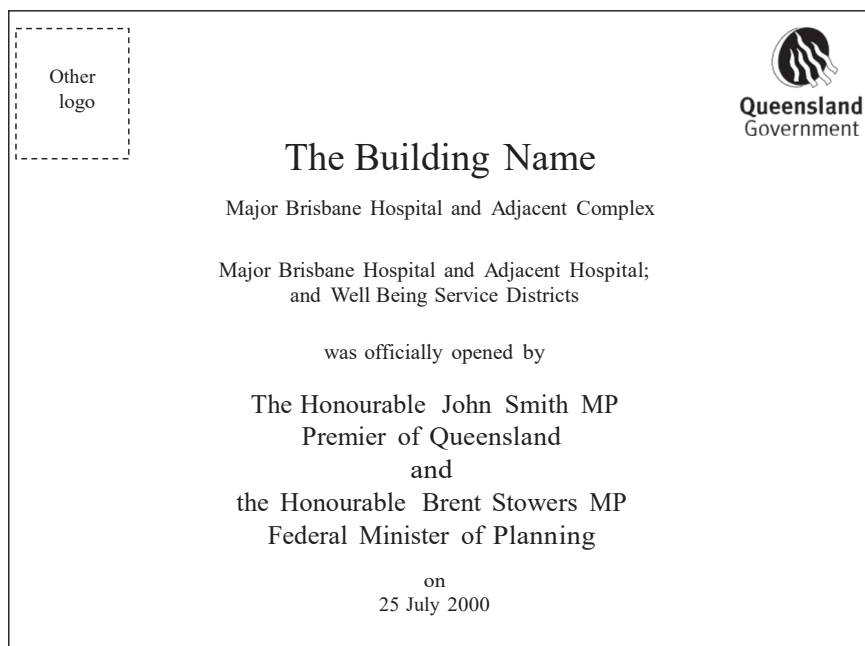
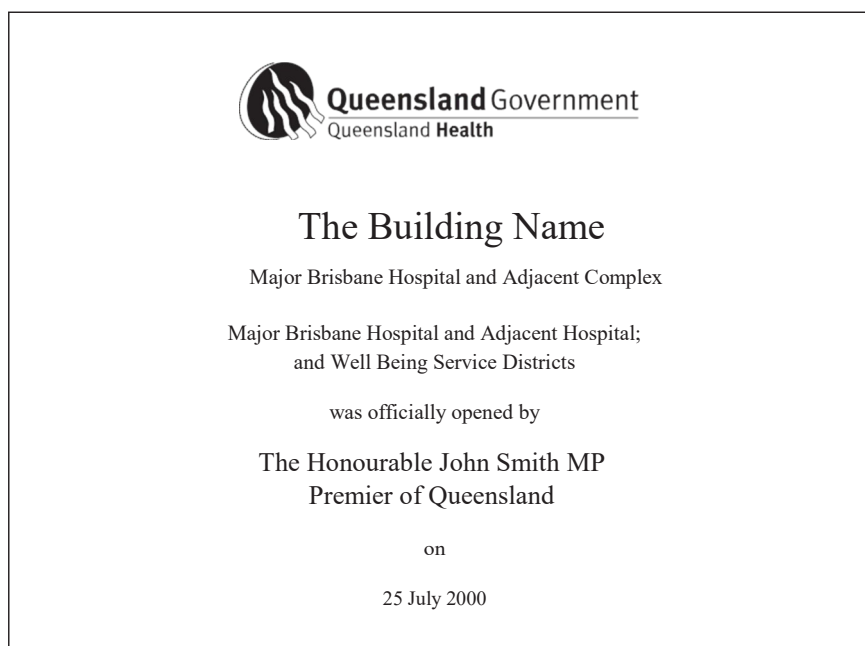


As with project signs, these should carry the Queensland Government dominant logo or a Queensland Government logo. The latter is preferred.

In situations involving external entities, the business relationship format (7.12) should be used as a guide for placement of respective logos.

Care is required when creating plaques to ensure that the State Government symbol does not appear in “albino” form (i.e. light shield and dark rays). This is contrary to the design principles. Attention is required when checking proofs to ensure the selected logo is appropriate for the plaque material (eg stone, brushed aluminium, brass).
