- Executive Director

Performance of the powers, functions, authorities and duties by the authorised officers must be documented in a manner compliant with the *Public Records Act 2002*, the Queensland Government's *Records Governance Policy*, and the *Records governance policy implementation guideline*.

This Instrument of Authorisation revokes any Instrument of Delegation or Authorisation concerning the Office of Industrial Relations previously issued with respect to the powers, functions, authorities and duties of the Director-General under the *Public Records Act 2002* and/or *Information Standard 31: Retention and disposal of public records* (IS31) except as hereinafter provided.

This Instrument of Authorisation does not revoke or replace any Instrument of Authorisation to Officers of the Department of Education, not employed within the Office of Industrial Relations, previously issued with respect to the powers, functions, authorities and duties of the Director-General under the *Public Records Act 2002*.
