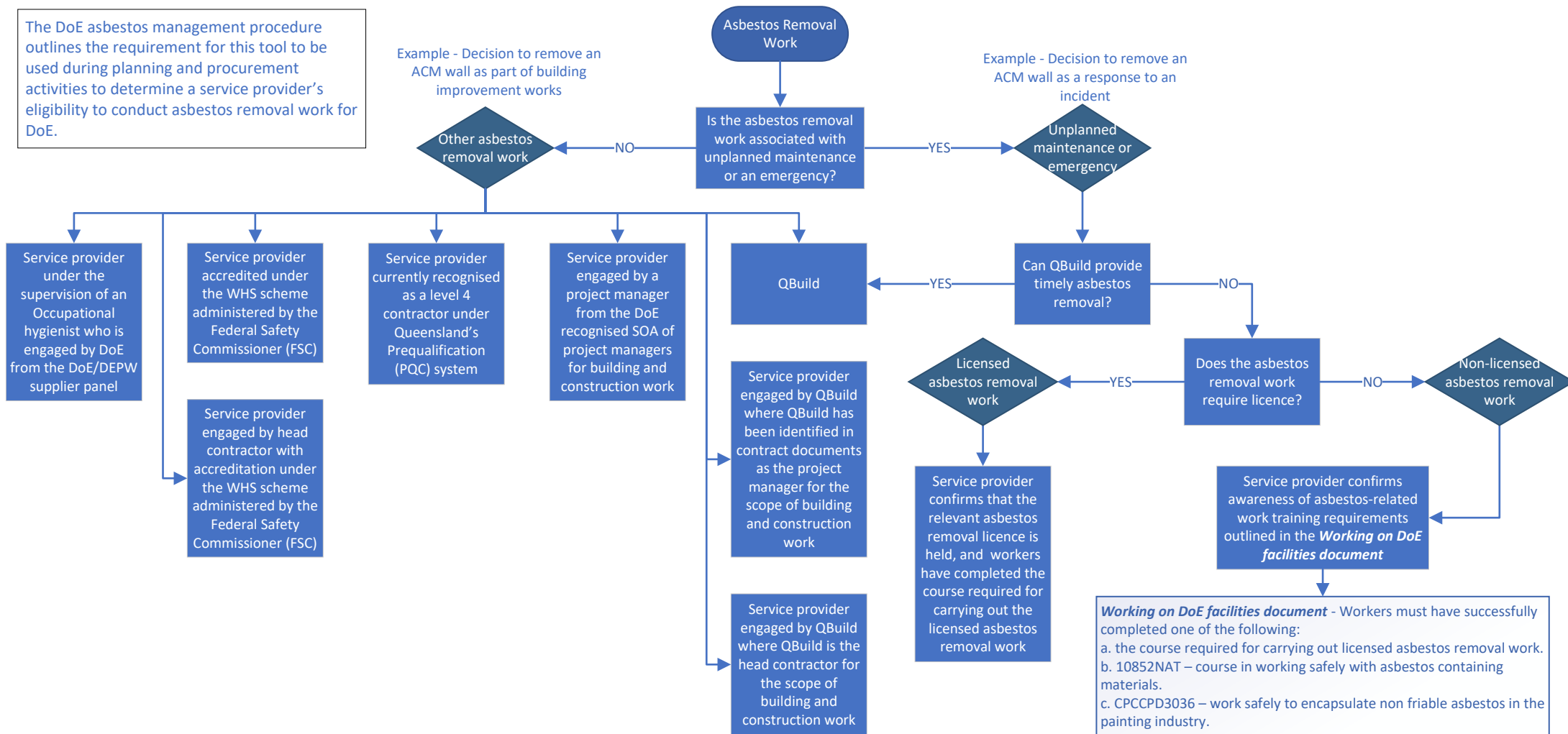


# Asbestos removal service provider eligibility criteria

The DoE asbestos management procedure outlines the requirement for this tool to be used during planning and procurement activities to determine a service provider's eligibility to conduct asbestos removal work for DoE.

**Working on DoE facilities document** - Workers must have successfully completed one of the following:

- the course required for carrying out licensed asbestos removal work.
- 10852NAT – course in working safely with asbestos containing materials.
- CPCCPD3036 – work safely to encapsulate non friable asbestos in the painting industry.
- a nationally recognised accredited course, delivered by a Registered Training Organisation, that would entitle a person to supervise or remove bonded asbestos under a licence or registration in an Australian jurisdiction.
- An asbestos awareness training course recognised by DoE for asbestos related work.
