
FLOWCHART: Process for animal-use activities in schools



For all activities involving animals, schools are to:

- · meet duty of care obligations for animals and ensure all aspects of animal-use activities are justified, ethical and respectful of animals
- · have relevant and current permits or licence
- ensure staff are suitably qualified, and that students and others involved in activities have relevant knowledge, skills and/or experience and/or are supervised by suitably qualified mentors
- arrange alternate activities and/or reasonable adjustments to meet student needs
- make appropriate resources available to meet animal welfare needs
- implement controls to address health, safety, wellbeing and/or curriculum activity risks
- adhere to relevant legislation, departmental procedures, and follow current best practice for animal welfare.
